

COMMENTS

Grayson Broadcasting Company ("GBC"), by counsel, and pursuant to Section 1.415 of the Commission's rules, hereby submits its comments in support of the Notice of Proposed Rule Making and Order to Show Cause, DA 98-860 (released May 8, 1998) ("NPRM"), proposing the allotment of Channel 273C3 to Pottsboro, Texas, as that community's first local aural transmission service.

GBC initiated this proceeding through its "Petition for Rulemaking," filed October 24, 1997. If the Commission should adopt its proposal and allot Channel 273C3 at Pottsboro, GBC hereby states that it will apply for a construction permit for a new FM station to operate on Channel 273C3 at Pottsboro, Texas, and, if its application is granted, will promptly construct the new facility to serve Pottsboro and the surrounding area as that community's first local broadcast service.

As noted in the NPRM, the proposed allotment of Channel 273C3 at Pottsboro, the proposed substitution of Channel 292A for Channel 296C3 at Durant, Oklahoma, and the proposed substitution of Channel 296A for Channel 273A at Madill, Oklahoma, can all be made in compliance

with the Commission's minimum distance separation requirements. Moreover, Channel 273C3 can be allotted to Pottsboro without a site restriction, and would provide the community of Pottsboro with its first local broadcast service. Therefore, the proposed allotment of Channel 273C3 at Pottsboro, Texas, would serve the public interest.

WHEREFORE, in light of the foregoing, Grayson Broadcasting Company respectfully requests that Channel 273C3 be allotted to Pottsboro, Texas, as that community's first local broadcast service.


