The Land Mobile Communication Council is seeking to reallocate the frequency bands 420-430 and 440-450 Mhz for the use of the Private Mobile Radio Service. These bands are now heavily used by radio amateurs, operating in the Amateur Radio Service, for a variety of public service and public interest communication. The reallocation proposed by LMCC is incompatible with these operations. In time of emergency's, these bands will not be there for us to use for the good and the welfare of the people.
