Dear Ms. Salas:

On June 30, 1998, the undersigned met with Susan Fox, Senior Legal Advisor to Chairman William E. Kennard, on behalf of the group of over 110 participants in the wireless cable industry that submitted the petition for rulemaking that commenced this proceeding (the "Petitioners").

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the proposals advanced by the Petitioners to protect Multipoint Distribution Service and Instructional Television Fixed Service from harmful electrical interference, focusing primarily on the Petitioners' proposed retention of the mandatory 0 dB adjacent channel desired-to-undesired signal interference protection ratio, the development of a conservative methodology for predicting compliance with that ratio, and the "safety net" of requiring the licensee of any response station to cure any unpredicted interference it causes. In addition, the need for streamlined processing of applications was discussed. The substance of the presentation is set forth in the formal comments and reply comments and *ex parte* submissions previously filed by the Petitioners in response to the *Notice of Proposed Rulemaking*.
