In accordance with the Commission's rules governing ex parte communications, please be advised that Dale (Zeke) Robertson, Senior Vice President, SBC Telecommunications, Inc., met yesterday with Kathryn C. Brown, Chief of the Common Carrier Bureau, and her counsel, Katherine Schroder, to discuss the federal regulatory priorities of SBC Communications Inc., its subsidiaries, and affiliates. The attached outline served as a basis for the discussion. Mr. Robertson urged the Commission to reaffirm jurisdiction over and re-confirm that Internet traffic is interstate for regulatory purposes and not subject to reciprocal compensation under local interconnection rules.
