On July 8, 1998, Carl W. Northrop and the undersigned, counsel for Columbia Millimeter Communications, L.P. and for Astrolink Communications, Inc., met with D'wana Terry, Chief of the Public Safety and Private Wireless Division of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, to discuss the above-referenced proceeding involving microwave services in the 38.6 - 40.0 GHz frequency band.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the legal, policy, and equitable implications of the Commission's decision in the Report and Order in the above-referenced docket to dismiss all pending mutually exclusive 39 GHz applications. The Commission's ongoing efforts to dispose of all pending 39 GHz applications also were discussed; the attached handout was provided.
