ORDER



Under consideration are "Jerry Szoka's Motion For A Brief Extension Of Time To File Opposition To CIB's Motion For Summary Decision" filed July 24, 1998, and "Compliance and Information Bureau's Reply To Jerry Szoka's Second Motion For Extension Of Time Within Which To File Opposition To Motion For Summary Decision" filed July 27, 1998.

By Order released June 26, 1998, (FCC 98M-87) the Presiding Judge granted Szoka's request for a thirty day extension of time in which to file his opposition to the Bureau's Motion for Summary Decision. Szoka now seeks a further four day extension to July 28. The brief extension will be granted. However, Szoka is put on notice that he has received more than ample time to prepare his response and that no further extensions will be granted.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that "Jerry Szoka's Motion For A Brief Extension Of Time To File Opposition To CIB's Motion For Summary Decision" filed July 24, 1998 IS GRANTED and the time to respond to the Bureau's Motion For Summary Decision IS EXTENDED to July 28, 1998.
