**FCC ANNOUNCES THE NORTH AMERICAN NUMBERING  
COUNCIL'S NEW CO-CHAIR, AND ADDS A NEW NARUC MEMBER  
TO THE COUNCIL**

(CC Docket No. 92-237)

At a meeting of the North American Numbering Council (NANC), held on Wednesday, July 22, 1998, at 8:30 a.m., at the Federal Communications Commission, 1919 M Street, NW, Room 856, Washington, DC, NANC Chairman Alan Hasselwander announced that Ronald J. Binz will serve as Co-Chair to the Council. Chairman Hasselwander also welcomed a new National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners (NARUC) member to the Council, Pennsylvania Public Utility Commissioner David Rolka, and his alternate, Amy Putnam.

Mr. Binz represents the Competition Policy Institute (CPI), a non-profit organization established to develop and advocate policies which bring the benefits of competition to consumers of telecommunications and energy services, and is its President and Policy Director. Until 1995, Binz directed the Colorado Office of Consumer Counsel (OCC), the state's utility consumer advocate. Binz has served as President, National Association of State Utility Consumer Advocates (NASUCA), and on the Federal Communications Commission's Network Reliability Council. He is also a member of the Harvard Electricity Policy Group. Binz received a B.A. in Philosophy from St. Louis University in 1971, a M.A. in Mathematics from the University of Colorado in 1977, and has completed course work for a Masters Degree in Economics at the University of Colorado.
