

Jeanne Will (dwill@w-link.net) writes:

I would like to express my dissatisfaction with recent policy changes that have resulted in the loss of local programming from the Dish Network. We are unable to receive a clear local signal in Mukilteo, even with an antenna, so are reduced to watching news from L. A. Contrary to what some may think, Los Angeles is not representative of the entire west coast, and I resent the F. C. C.'s apparant belief that it is. I get up very early in the morning to go to work, and I miss not being able to find out what's happening in my community while I'm having breakfast. Likewise, I am not happy to think that in order to regain local programming, we will have to add a second dish to our service. I feel that this regulation gives definite unfair advantage to the cable services. We switched from cable to satellite in the first place because we were not happy with the service provided. With this regulation, the F. C. C. has removed our choices.
