We purchased a DISH Network satellite system because we were so terribly unahppy with the TCI Cable Network. We live in a south suburb of Seattle, WA and one of the real deciding factors in purchasing the DISH Network was that one of the West Coast Feed channels was KOMO Channel 4, the ABC affiliate in Seattle.
