This is to inform you that on September 2, 1998, Al Varner, Alice Harms and the undersigned, all of BellSouth Corporation, participated in a teleconference with Quyen Truong of the Common Carrier Bureau's Policy and Program Planning Division about issues relating to BellSouth's pending application for authorization to provide in-region, interLATA telecommunications services in Louisiana.

During the conversation, Mr. Varner described the contents of BellSouth's Collocation Negotiation Handbook and the BellSouth Ordering Guide. He also explained the differences in the Louisiana Public Service Commission's procedures for handling changes to those documents and changes to its BellSouth's Statement of Generally Accepted Terms and Conditions to which these other documents are attachments. He also reviewed with Ms. Truong the part of his affidavit and related attachments addressing BellSouth's pricing of UNE combos for which the competitive local exchange carrier does the required recombination.
