**ENL-VSL WITHDRAWAL OF MOTION  
REGARDING THE PROTECTIVE ORDER  
AND MOBEX DOCUMENTS**

Environmental LLC (“ENL”) and Verde Systems LLC (“VSL”) (together “ENL-VSL”), through their undersigned counsel, hereby withdraw their pending motion regarding the Protective Order and certain Mobex documents. Mr. Havens joins in this filing (together, “EVH”).

For hearing efficiency and other reasons indicated herein, the motion which related to Issue (g), is withdrawn without prejudice to refiling the motion, or one involving matters in the motion, after the Presiding Judge has determined how the hearing under all issues in the HDO, FCC 11-64, will proceed in light of the Commission's September 11, 2014 decision, FCC 14-133, that denies the Maritime/Choctaw Second Thursday application and directs the Presiding Judge to proceed with a hearing on all issues in the HDO. EVH does not wish to take time at the Status Conference on October 1, 2014, to address matters other than how the hearing will proceed in light of the September 11 Commission decision.

Until the course of the hearing on all HDO issues is determined, it would not appear efficient or effective to proceed with the motion. The HDO issues are related and Issue (g) is clearly related to the other issues, as expressly set forth in Issues (h) and (i), which refer to Issue (g) among other foregoing issues. A full hearing under the HDO unduly has been delayed by the MCLM-Choctaw actions in the MCLM bankruptcy and the Second Thursday application and the stay of the proceedings on all but issue (g). This in turn has resulted in MCLM keeping abandoned and terminated stations at play in these and other proceedings for years. Furthermore, MCLM and the Bureau have sought summary decision on the narrow Issue (g) and continue in their direct cases to seek to allow MCLM to keep the 16 stations without dealing with the other issues in the HDO.

In short, EVH do not wish to continue to pursue a motion that would distract the Status Conference from dealing with the September 11 Order and proceeding to a full hearing under the HDO. Once the hearing is finally underway on all the issues in the HDO, then motions for particular purposes, considering the whole case and all the interrelated issues, can be considered and efficiently pursued.

**Conclusion**

Wherefore, for the foregoing reasons, the pending motion is withdrawn without prejudice.
