Dear FCC Office of the Secretary:

As a consulting engineer who does use the services of the current frequency coordinators, I would like to comment on the petition by ACD Telecom LLC (reference FCC DA 14-1292, September 8, 2014) on my personal experience with ACD Telecom.

I am familiar with their capabilities and services in the past, and I do find them to meet and exceed the expectations that I believe a frequency coordinator must have. Per the criteria that the FCC established in 1986 for PLMR frequency coordination, I do feel that they will perform coordination with the stated criteria of:

- (a) **Representativeness of the users of the frequencies to be coordinated;** My personal experience with them is that they do understand the needs of my clients and the importance of getting the applications in to the FCC in a timely manner;
- (b) **The entity's overall coordination plan (including how recommendations would be made and equality of applicant treatment);** ACD is very familiar with the FCC rules and regulations and does treat all entities with the fairness that a frequency coordinator must have;
- (c) **The entity's experience coordinating frequencies in the service or technical expertise;** ACD (staff and management) has worked in the capacity as a frequency coordinator manager for one of the major FCC approved frequency coordination entities, and does thoroughly understand both the technical side of the radio frequency coordination and the procedural side of getting the coordination done correctly and with the due diligence that is required of someone doing that work. I know that their RF engineers have

worked with many of the national committees that have helped guide the FCC and other regulatory agencies on technical and procedural issues that involve complex radio systems.


(d) **Its nationwide coordination capability;** I know that ACD has performed frequency coordination all over the United States and is able to have a national capability.

I know that they are methodical in their approach to any problem, and I would feel that the FCC would be doing the radio users in the US a great service by having ACD Telecom as one of their certified frequency coordinators for Part 90 public safety applications.

I urge the FCC to approve ACD Telecom's petition to become a frequency coordinator for the Part 90 public safety applications.
