
Dear Ms. Dortch:

By this letter, Norcast Communications Corporation, FRN 0008660763 (“Norcast”) is notifying the Commission of the proposed transfer of a portion of the customer base of Blue Rooster Telecom, Inc., FRN 0019631415 to Norcast.

The types of services provided to the affected customers include interstate exchange access and interstate and international interexchange (toll) services, as well as intrastate local exchange and interexchange services. The proposed date of the transfer is on or about November 1, 2014, or as soon thereafter as all required regulatory authorizations are received and applicable advance notice periods expire.


