DIRECTV hereby responds to the Commission's September 9, 2014 Information and Discovery Request ("Request").¹

Pursuant to the terms of the *Joint Protective Order*,² DIRECTV has identified certain aspects of its response as Highly Confidential Information. DIRECTV submits herewith one copy of the *redacted*, public version of this filing, which clearly denotes where Highly Confidential Information has been redacted.

An *unredacted*, Highly Confidential version of this filing has also been submitted to the Office of the Secretary pursuant to the terms of the *Joint Protective Order*, and will be made available for inspection pursuant to the terms of the *Joint Protective Order* and the Bureau's October 7, 2014 *Order* (DA 14-1463).³ In addition to the narrative responses and schedules, documents responsive to the Request have been submitted in electronic form to the Media Bureau and to the Commission's contractor, consistent with the instructions in the Request and directions from the Media Bureau staff. The narrative answers, data, and documents respond to the Request as clarified by conversations between representatives of DIRECTV and the Commission. The resulting modifications to the Request are further detailed in DIRECTV's response.
