Re: Notice of Permitted Ex Parte Presentation – Wireless E911 Location Accuracy Requirements, PS Docket No. 07-114

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On October 7, 2014, James Arden Barnett, Jr. and Frederick M. Joyce of the law firm Venable LLP, attorneys representing TruePosition, Inc., along with Stuart Salen, Senior Vice President and General Counsel for TruePosition and Robert Anderson, Senior Vice President for Technology & Engineering and Chief Technology Officer for TruePosition, met with Julius Knapp, Chief of the Office of Engineering and Technology (“OET”) of the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) and Walter Johnston, Chief of OET’s Electromagnetic Compatibility Division.

During this meeting, the representatives from TruePosition discussed:

1. The technical aspects of how UTDOA’s network-based technology satisfies or exceeds the FCC’s proposed 50 meter indoor location accuracy requirement, its reliability, very low latency, and its availability from more than one vendor;
2. That “dispatchable address” is a worthy aspirational goal, but further rulemaking proceedings would be required to define its parameters and operations. By contrast, the proposed indoor location accuracy rules can be adopted now and will build towards a capability for “dispatchable address” when it is a fully developed and delineated concept;
3. How the FCC’s proposed indoor location accuracy standards will provide a foundation for even more accurate location systems in the future, including the ability to incorporate and distinguish accurate signals of opportunity from WLAN-based signals that might otherwise be inaccurate or misleading; and

4. How E911 indoor accuracy costs for carriers could be significantly reduced through a shared solution, which would also further improve indoor location accuracy.
