On October 7, 2014, Rick Chessen of the National Cable & Telecommunications Association (NCTA) and Walter Anderson of Harris, Wiltshire & Grannis LLP met with Chad Breckinridge, Associate Bureau Chief in the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, to discuss the above-referenced proceedings. Specifically, we commended the Commission's efforts to facilitate wireless infrastructure deployment, which will promote increased wireless broadband access for consumers nationwide. We also discussed the increasingly important role Wi-Fi based services are playing in the broadband ecosystem, and we emphasized that the Commission's policies should not inadvertently undermine the deployment of facilities that support Wi-Fi based services.
