Dear Ms. Dortch:

On October 9, 2014, I had a telephone conversation with Lisa Hone, the Deputy Division Chief of the Telecommunications Access Policy Division of the Wireline Competition Bureau on behalf of my client, Internet2, related to the eligible services list (“ESL”) for the Schools and Libraries Universal Support Mechanism (“E-rate program”) for funding year 2015. I informed Ms. Hone that Internet2 takes no position on whether the ESL for funding year 2015 should or should not contain a list of ineligible services that had been posted at the end of each category of service, as in prior years. Consistent with Internet2’s comments in this proceeding and the Commission’s *2010 E-rate Reform Order*, however, I reiterated Internet2’s position that if the ESL for funding year 2015 does contain a list of ineligible services, Internet2 should not be listed in the glossary section of the ESL as being ineligible for funding as an Internet access provider, nor should there be any other specific references to Internet2 or its service as being somehow ineligible.
