**Re: Acceleration of Broadband Deployment by Improving Wireless Facilities Siting Policies (WT Docket No. 13-238); Acceleration of Broadband Deployment: Expanding the Reach and Reducing the Cost of Broadband Deployment by Improving Policies Regarding Public Rights of Way and Wireless Facilities Siting (WC Docket No. 11-59)**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On October 14, 2014, the undersigned had a telephone conversation to discuss the above-referenced proceedings with Chad Breckinridge of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau.

Specially, during the call we discussed the pending Order on wireless infrastructure and the proposed shot clock timeframe that would apply to Section 6409 installations. We urged that a 90-day timeframe be adopted and voiced concerns about decreasing that period to 60 or 45 days as some commenters have proposed. We especially objected to a 45-day timeframe as simply being too short a time within which all local governments would be compelled to act.
