This letter is submitted pursuant to Section 1.1206 of the Commission's Rules to disclose the communications made in the above-referenced proceedings.


On October 21, 2014, Commissioner Pai and his staff visited Station WTAW(AM), College Station, Texas, where Commissioner Pai was interviewed on the station's program, The Infomaniacs. During the visit, Commissioner Pai met with William Hicks and Ben Downs, President and Vice President, respectively, of Bryan Broadcasting Corporation ("Bryan Broadcasting"), which controls the licensee of several radio stations¹ in and around the Bryan/College Station Texas radio market, including WTAW(AM). Commissioner Pai and Mr. Downs discussed the status of the AM Revitalization process and the value that FM translators would bring to small AM stations, especially daytime stations. Mr. Hicks discussed the value of sharing radio and newspaper news gathering resources in micro-markets like Buffalo, Texas.
