On August 8, 2014, the Federal Communications Commission adopted a *Second Report and Order and Third Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking* in the Text-to-911 proceeding.<sup>1</sup> The *Third Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (Third Further Notice)* portion of the item set deadlines for filing comments and reply comments at 30 and 60 days after publication in the Federal Register.

On September 16, 2014, a summary of the *Third Further Notice* appeared in the Federal Register.<sup>2</sup> Accordingly, comments will be due on or before Thursday, October 16, 2014, and reply comments will be due on or before Monday, November 17, 2014. The *Third Further Notice* sets forth the comment filing instructions.
