COMMENTS OF ION MEDIA ATLANTA LICENSE, INC.

ION Media Atlanta License, Inc. ("Licensee"), licensee of WPXA-TV, Rome, Georgia (the "Station"), by its attorneys and pursuant to Sections 1.415, 1.419 and 1.420 of the Commission's Rules (47 C.F.R. §§ 1.415, 1.419, 1.420), hereby submits these comments regarding the above-captioned *Notice of Proposed Rule Making* ("Notice") released September 4, 2014. The *Notice* seeks comment on Licensee's request, as set forth in its *Petition for Rule Making* dated August 11, 2014 and supplemented August 19, 2014 (collectively, the "*Petition*"), that the Commission amend the post-transition DTV Table of Allotments to substitute Channel 31 as the Station's DTV channel in lieu of Channel 51.

Licensee hereby confirms its continuing interest in the proposal as set forth in the *Petition*, which is incorporated herein by reference. As Licensee explained in the *Petition*, the channel change would allow the Station to essentially replicate the coverage of its current licensed facility and would not affect the Commission's repacking flexibility. Moreover, the cessation of operations on Channel 51 would eliminate potential interference with wireless operations in the adjacent Lower 700 MHz A Block. If the Commission adopts the proposed channel change, Licensee intends to apply for authorization to operate WPXA-TV on Channel 31

and implement the change in accordance with the Commission's rules. Licensee respectfully requests that if the Commission adopts the proposed channel change, the change be made effective upon the release of the Report and Order in this proceeding.

THEREFORE, for the reasons herein and previously set forth in the *Petition*, Licensee respectfully requests that the Commission promptly adopt the changes proposed in the *Notice*.
