As President of the Greater Manchester Chamber of Commerce (GMCC) in New Hampshire, I write to share some perspectives on behalf of the GMCC regarding the transaction between Comcast and Time Warner Cable (TWC). The GMCC has not formally taken a position on this transaction, however, we can speak to Comcast's long time involvement and support in the business community and as a community partner.

The GMCC has been a Comcast Business customer since 2009 and we greatly appreciate Comcast's service as well as their support for a variety of community initiatives, role as a strong corporate citizen and supporter of the business community. Just last December, Comcast installed new cable modem equipment enabling us to offer WiFi connectivity to our staff and public at our downtown visitor center.
