The Commission Staff has advised AT&T Inc. (“AT&T”) that certain documents relating to contracts for Managed Internet Services are non-responsive to the Commission’s Information and Discovery Request (“Request”). Accordingly, AT&T is withdrawing Exhibits 75.1.01-75.1.273 and the corresponding Bates numbers ATT-FCC-03371936 - ATT-FCC-03374765 in its document production as well as Exhibit 81.g from its response to the Request (“Response”).


To implement this withdrawal, pursuant to the *Joint Protective Order* and *Modified Joint Protective Order* in the above-referenced proceeding¹ and at the request of the Commission Staff, AT&T is filing with the Secretary’s Office an unredacted Highly Confidential copy of one DVD-ROM and one hard drive to replace those that were originally produced on October 7, 2014 as part of AT&T’s Response. These replacements do not contain Exhibits 75.1.01-75.1.273, the corresponding Bates numbers ATT-FCC-03371936 - ATT-FCC-03374765 in AT&T’s document production and Exhibit 81.g. A copy of the unredacted DVD-ROM is being delivered to the Commission Staff.
