Dear Ms. Dortch:

On October 30, 2014, Joan Marsh, representing AT&T, spoke via telephone with Brendan Carr, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Ajit Pai, to discuss the above captioned matters.

Ms. Marsh discussed the need for modernization of the rules regarding cellular licensing and the need for quick Commission action on the order, which is currently on circulation at the Commission. With regard to roaming, Ms. Marsh reiterated that the current roaming rules, established in the 2011 Data Roaming Order, struck the proper balance between ensuring that availability of data services and maintaining the proper incentives for carriers to build-out. Ms. Marsh also noted that any carrier who believes it cannot secure commercial reasonable data roaming arrangements can file a complaint with the FCC.
