On October 30, 2014, the undersigned, along with Mr. Richard Bilotti, Portfolio Manager for Special Situations for P. Schoenfeld Asset Management LP and Mr. Michael Pausic, Partner, Foxhaven Asset Management, LP, met with Commissioner Michael O'Rielly; Ms. Erin McGrath, Legal Advisor to Commissioner O'Rielly for Wireless, Public Safety, and International Issues; and Ms. Amy Bender, Legal Advisor to Commissioner O'Rielly for Wireline Issues.

The purpose of the meeting was to provide the Commission with a perspective regarding developments in the video programming distribution and internet services markets, and how policies being considered in the above-referenced proceedings may affect various market participants and investment in those markets. In particular, the parties discussed the market effects and statutory issues associated with potentially expanding the regulatory definition of a "multichannel video programming distributor," the effect of programmer bundling on multichannel video programming rates, the advantages of usage based billing for consumers and for the development of broadband networks, the appropriate scope of a regulatory definition for "managed" or "specialized" services, and the potential technical constraints and market effects associated with the growth of those services.
