PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Charles Crawford hereby requests the allotment of Channel 295A to Wright City, Oklahoma,¹ as that community's first local transmission service. The following summarizes the changes requested in this Petition:

Wright City, Oklahoma qualifies as a "community" for FCC allotment purposes.

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 295A to

Wright City, Oklahoma as that community's first local service. Wright City is an incorporated city in McCurtain County, Oklahoma. The population was 762 at the 2010 census. Wright City has its own city hall, post office, volunteer fire department, independent school district, police department, a number of local churches, a chamber of commerce and a number of local businesses. Also, Wright City hosts one of the oldest continuous rodeos in Oklahoma, known as Little Cheyenne, held each July 1 through 4.

Wright City is a community that is certainly deserving of a first FM service. "Local radio stations play an important role in their communities, providing local news, information and entertainment to residents, and generally serving as good corporate citizens in the local community life. This is particularly true in smaller towns where the radio stations are limited in number. Yet there are still rural areas of our country that do not have even a local radio station."² The proposed channel 295A will provide additional diversity and an outlet for local self-expression to Wright City residents and therefore is in the public interest.




