PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Charles Crawford hereby requests the allotment of Channel 247A to Bogata, Texas,¹ as that community's first local transmission service. The following summarizes the changes requested in this Petition:

Bogata, Texas qualifies as a "community" for FCC allotment purposes.

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 247A to

Bogata, Texas as that community's first local service. Bogata is an incorporated city in Red River County, Texas. The population was 1,153 at the 2010 census. Bogata has its own city hall, post office, fire department, independent school district, police department, a number of churches, chamber of commerce and a number of local businesses.

Bogata is a community that is certainly deserving of a first FM service. "Local radio stations play an important role in their communities, providing local news, information and entertainment to residents, and generally serving as good corporate citizens in the local community life. This is particularly true in smaller towns where the radio stations are limited in number. Yet there are still rural areas of our country that do not have even a local radio station."² The proposed channel 247A will provide additional diversity and an outlet for local self-expression to Bogata residents and therefore is in the public interest.

Channel 247A/ Bogata, Texas

Attached hereto is a channel study confirming that Channel 247A can be allocated to Bogata, Texas, consistent with Section 73.207 of the Commission's Rules³ with respect




