COMMENTS

Entravision Holdings, LLC (“Entravision”), the licensee of Station KCEC(TV), Denver, Colorado (the “Station”), by its attorneys and pursuant to Sections 1.415, 1.419 and 1.420 of the Commission's Rules,¹ hereby submits these Comments in response to *Notice of Proposed Rulemaking*, DA 14-1502, released October 17, 2014 (“NPRM”).² The NPRM requests comments as to Entravision’s Petition for Rulemaking, submitted on October 6, 2014, requesting that the Commission amend Section 73.622(i), the Post-Transition DTV Table of Allotments, by substituting Channel 26 for Channel 51, as the Station's Post-Transition DTV output channel. In support thereof, Entravision states as follows.

Entravision hereby confirms its continuing interest in the proposal it has submitted, which is hereby incorporated by reference. As Entravision stated in its Petition, the proposed channel change would allow the Station to continue to operate, with its broadcast facilities

replicated in their entirety, so that the Station's viewing public would in no way be impacted by the channel change. In addition, by moving the Station from operations on Channel 51 to operations on Channel 26, the change would eliminate the potential impact of the Station to wireless service operating in the adjacent Lower 700 MHz A Block.


Should the Commission grant the proposed channel change, Entravision intends to apply for an authorization to operate the Station on Channel 26 and implement such change upon Commission approval and consistent with Commission requirements.

Entravision requests that the Commission, in adopting this channel change request, make the channel change effective upon the release of the Report and Order in this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons and as previously described in Entravision's Petition, Entravision respectfully requests that the Commission adopt the changes to amend the Post-Transition DTV Table of Allotments as proposed.
