Dear Ms. Dortch:

My name is Adam Reuter and I am the owner of Baltimore Digital Studios. I was unhappy to hear about the possible auction/repurposing of the 600 MHz frequency spectrum. It would hurt my company financially to have to repurchase wireless audio equipment. In addition, my understanding that the last remaining “unlicensed spectrum” is weaker/more susceptible to interference than the 600 MHz band.

Sennheiser has proposed reserving two UHF blocks for monitoring and microphone usage. I support their proposal. Not reserving these blocks would be a huge slap in the face to media production.

Because I will more than likely be forced to buy new equipment, the auction winners should be forced to pay for my new equipment. This situation is analogous to someone showing up and ripping out all of the phone/internet lines from the FCC building. My equipment will be broken in a few years because of this and I’m not happy about it one bit.
