In accordance with Section 1.1206 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206, we hereby provide you with notice of an oral ex parte presentation in connection with the above-captioned proceedings. On November 12, 2014, as part of a larger industry group meeting, the undersigned met with FCC Chairman Tom Wheeler, and Daniel Alvarez (Office of Chairman Wheeler), Jonathan Sallet and Stephanie Weiner (Office of the General Counsel), Roger Sherman (Wireless Telecommunications Bureau), Matthew DelNero (Wireline Competition Bureau) and Eric Feigenbaum (Office of Media Relations).

During the course of meeting, U.S. Cellular expressed its believe that whatever jurisdictional basis the Commission uses to pursue open internet rules, that wireless carriers need the ability to engage in reasonable network management practices. I also stated our belief that the Commission should issue a further notice seeking additional public comment on whatever proposal the Chairman intends to ask the Commission to vote upon.
