On December 7, 2012, Western Pacific Broadcast, LLC ("Western Pacific"), licensee of television station WACP, Atlantic City, New Jersey, by its attorneys filed a must carry complaint against Blue Ridge Cable Technologies ("Blue Ridge"), seeking carriage of station WACP on Blue Ridge's cable system serving the Philadelphia designated market area.
