On November 13, 2014, Jim Cicconi and Bob Quinn, on behalf of AT&T, met with Phillip Verveer, Senior Counselor to Chairman Wheeler, and with Jon Sallet, the Commission's General Counsel. During the meeting, they discussed the above-referenced proceedings.

In particular, they discussed the Commission's authority to prohibit paid prioritization and other practices that harm consumers or competition under Section 706 of the Communications Act. Consistent with AT&T's comments, they discussed the deficiencies of reclassification under Title II. They also discussed problems associated with hybrid legal theories for protecting and promoting the Open Internet, as a consequence of their reliance on Title II.
