Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to the Commission's Report and Order of September 26, 2013 in the above-referenced proceeding, in accordance with the Public Notice of June 17, 2014 and the Commission's associated Instructions for the Mandatory Data Collection and consistent with the Protective Order of December 19, 2013 in WC Docket No. 12-375,¹ CenturyLink hereby supplements its submission of September 16, 2014.

CenturyLink's September 16, 2014 submission included requested data for both jails and prisons, which was provided in an Excel spreadsheet in the template format required by the Commission. CenturyLink recently learned that information for two ancillary fees had been inadvertently omitted from its initial filing. This supplemental data provides the information requested in the Data Collection for those two fees. The enclosed Excel spreadsheet includes this additional information for the Ancillary Fees tab. There are no changes to the information previously provided in CenturyLink's September 16, 2014 submission.
