But the price for one 20 minute phone call is outrageous. I'm calling my family from Dillwyn Virginia to Norfolk Virginia, and a collect call will run me at a max \$8.55 and a pre-paid or Debt call will run me at a max \$7.75. Dillwyn to Norfolk is anywhere from an hour an twenty-five to an hour an forty-five minute drive. A lot of money is being missed out on because of the prices also, cause I only call home maybe once a month because I can't afford to call anymore than that. I truly disagree with the prices that the phone companies are charging us as inmates and something should be done about it. If interstate (Long distance) prison phone rate can be capped and reduced than so should in-state phone rates.
