On November 21, 2014, James Arden Barnett, Jr. of the law firm Venable LLP and John T. Nakahata of the law firm Harris Wiltshire & Grannis LLP, attorneys representing Telcordia Technologies, Inc. d/b/a iconectiv (“Telcordia”), spoke via telephone conference with Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) staff Kenneth Moran, Senior Deputy Bureau Chief of the FCC’s Public Safety & Homeland Security Bureau (“PSHSB”), Allan Manuel, Associate Bureau Chief of PSHSB, and Gregory Intocchia, Senior Legal Counsel in the Cybersecurity and Communications Reliability Division of PSHSB.

The representatives from Telcordia answered a question posed by PSHSB regarding Sungard Availability Services (“Sungard AS”), a subcontractor for Telcordia’s NPAC proposal.
