On Monday, November 24th, I, Rashad Robinson, executive director of ColorOfChange.org, and James Rucker, co-founder of the organization, met with Commissioner Mignon Clyburn, Rebekah Goodheart, and an additional colleague of the commissioner.

During the meeting, Mr. Rucker and I both emphasized the importance of protecting the open Internet for protecting the voice of African-American communities and organizing efforts, and specifically the need to ensure that sufficient authority is used when attempting to implement the rules, namely by reclassifying broadband as a common carrier service using title II of the 1934 Telecommunications Act.
