Dear Ms. Dortch:

Globe Wireless, LLC (“Globe”) hereby relinquishes its Accounting Authority Identification Code (“AAIC”) US06.¹ On June 30, 2014, Globe notified the Commission pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 3.51 that it intended to cease performing settlements in connection with its planned dissolution.² On November 12, 2014, Globe and Inmarsat Solutions (US) Inc. (“Inmarsat”) withdrew their above-referenced application seeking Commission consent to the assignment of AAIC US06 to Inmarsat.³

No vessels are assigned to AAIC US06 and Globe is no longer performing settlements. Thus, there is no need for Globe to retain AAIC US06.
