I teach college classes as a volunteer at the Indiana Women's Prison in Indianapolis. The women in my courses are among the most motivated students I have had the pleasure to teach in forty years. They care deeply about becoming good role models for their children, especially in regard to their education. They struggle to stay in touch with their children without being a financial burden on them. Yet they only earn a few cents per hour, not nearly enough to contribute to the very high cost of calling home.

Nearly all of my students will return to their families someday—and most of those families are in-state. It is so important for them to have stayed in touch while incarcerated. I hope the FCC will impose caps on rates and eliminate commissions.
