Dear Ms. Dortch:

Comcast Corporation has determined that 28 documents were inadvertently produced to the Commission in response to the Commission’s August 21, 2014 Information and Data Request.¹ The documents, which are identified in Exhibit A, contain privileged attorney-client communications and/or attorney work product and were inadvertently included in prior productions.

Pursuant to the Modified Joint Protective Order in effect in this proceeding, and as set forth in Comcast’s previous correspondence regarding its production of documents in this proceeding, the inadvertent production of these documents does not constitute a waiver of any privilege or other protection to which Comcast is entitled with respect to these documents.² Comcast respectfully requests that the Commission destroy any versions of these documents, whether in hard copy or electronic form.

Comcast submitted today replacement versions of ten of these Highly Confidential documents that have been partially redacted; these ten documents are identified in Exhibit B. The first four documents listed in Exhibit B are versions of the same document. Some of the redacted documents contain Video
