On December 10, 2014, Richard Swann as counsel, Michael Romano, CEO of NexGen and I met with Tim May, David Siehl, Dana Zelman, and David Furth of the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau. We met concerning the efforts of NexGen to achieve a universal text to 911 solution as well as its ability to immediately deliver text and media on a call back basis.

Mr. Romano explained the need for NexGen to obtain access to the TCC database in order to achieve the final text to 911 solution


