

**FCC Comment About Marriott Blocking Personal Wireless Networks  
Proceeding Number: RM-11737**

Marriott was wrong to prevent its guests from using personal Wi-Fi networks. The FCC should stand by its original decision to fine them for inappropriate use of a Wi-Fi monitoring system and reinforce consumers' right to choose how to connect to the Internet. Anything less would be reprehensible.
