

Dear Secretary Dortch,

As the District Attorney of Lackawanna County, Scranton, Pennsylvania, I am writing to show my support towards the efforts requesting the Federal Communication Commission (FCC) to enact regulation that would allow telecommunication providers to collect and provide indoor cellular location data to law enforcement.

Since the technology exists to "pinpoint" indoor and outdoor locations of individuals using wireless communication devices, it makes sense to provide such information to law enforcement and other emergency responders because a majority of such "emergency" calls originate from wireless phones. There is no question that this is a legitimate public safety concern due to the fact that emergency responders/dispatchers are currently forced to rely on the best description a distressed caller can give as to their location. This location information is vital to not only saving lives but it would also assure that law enforcement would be following more precise information. Delayed responses and vague information could have devastating consequences.

As such, I urge the FCC to address this extremely important Public Safety matter.
