Pursuant to Sections 1.1206(b)(1) of the Commission's Rules, the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) and the People of the State of California submit this notice of a recent ex parte communication with FCC staff. The ex parte communication was oral and occurred at the request of CPUC staff via conference call on Thursday, December 4, 2014.

FCC staff who participated on the call were Sanford Williams, Ann Stevens, Michelle Sclater, Marilyn Jones, and Heather Hendrickson. CPUC staff who participated were Joanne Leung, Fe Lazaro, and Karen Eckersley.

CPUC requested the conference call to discuss the local number portability administration (LNPA) selection between NeuStar and Telcordia, specifically with regard to services the CPUC considers critical to 911 operations, and might impact 911 and public safety. In addition, the CPUC and FCC staff discussed whether the shortened transition time poses any special challenges to the new vendor.
