
Dear Ms. Dortch:

This letter is written on behalf of our client, Prime Time Christian Broadcasting, Inc. ("PTCB"), licensee of Stations KPTB-DT, Lubbock, Texas, KPCB-DT, Snyder, Texas, KPTF-DT, Farwell, Texas, KMLM-DT, Odessa, Texas, and KRPV-DT, Roswell, New Mexico, to request that the CALM Act Compliance Plan and Forbearance Request ("Compliance Plan") that it filed on December 11, 2014 be withdrawn, for the reasons that follow.

PTCB filed its Compliance Plan in the belief that its five stations were not in full compliance with the CALM Act's equipment requirements and needed up to six months to achieve full compliance. However, on December 12, 2014, PTCB's undersigned counsel and its Chief Engineer Delbert Dick had a very instructive conference call with Commission staff, who analyzed PTCB's current equipment and procedures and its proposed Compliance Plan, and concluded that much less new equipment, specifically only a loudness controller, was needed to achieve full compliance. PTCB expects to have that equipment purchased and installed within eight weeks from now. Under these circumstances, the staff stated that a compliance/forbearance plan was unnecessary, and recommended that PTCB should withdraw its December 11 pleading. **Accordingly, PTCB hereby withdraws its December 11, 2014 Compliance Plan and Forbearance Request.**
