RE: New e911 rules. PS Docket No. 07-114

As the Mayor of Jasper, a community in Southern Indiana with a population of 15,000, I see firsthand on a daily basis the importance of new technology in the role of emergency response.

The Mayor's Office, the Jasper Police Department and the Jasper Fire Department support new locator technology for mobile phones, specifically those pertaining to indoor accuracy and the requirement to provide a vertical location for devices used to make 911 calls. It is our understanding that such rule-making is underway and these new applications have broad industry support in the mobile communications field.

We recently had a fatal fire where three lives were lost in a second story blaze. I can only imagine the impact on this tragedy in Jasper if such new technology could have been employed.

Please give the utmost consideration to the improvement of mobile location services for e911.
