I want to thank you for caring enough for us inmates who are incarcerated and are extremely powerless over the system. I write you to notify you of the results that your campaign successfully did with the phone rates. There are still minor issues with the phones but that isn't of great concern. The rates are down and that does make a difference. I personally cannot afford to use the phone, and sadly enough, I honestly have no one in whom wants to speak to me anymore anyway, except for my 10 year old son. But his mother refuses to follow the court order. You would think that every parent would be civilized enough to think of the child's best interest and keep the child in contact with the non-custodial parent, but that don't seem to be true.

The issues of great concern now are of so many. Mostly due to the fact that, the prison now is (seemly spiteful) **DOCKET FILE COPY ORIGINAL** to make their money in other ways, due to them not being able to profit from the massive phone profits they once profited from.

This prison in particular is firing workers with top pay (¢.42 an hr.) and hiring at ¢.19 an hour. They are constantly raising commissary prices when the pay rates have not changed in 20 yrs. GLP is ¢.72 a day M-F unless it is a holiday. Black Friday is a Holiday that I never in my life got paid for on the street in my 16 years as an auto body tech. I've never heard of this being a holiday.

They are drastically cutting back on the cleaning supplies that are provided to clean the units and most importantly, our showers.

The medical department has a way of deceitfully forcing us to sign a blank check that would permit them to take whatever amount they see fit, out of our accounts, even if it is an ongoing existing condition (which is against policy). If we don't sign, we won't be seen.

They refuse to provide Long John Thermals and expect us to pay for them now. There are many things that they once provided and refuse to provide anymore. We used to be able to exchange our socks if they were beyond repair. Not anymore! We have to wait 1 year. We only are permitted 3 pairs at a time unless we buy them.

They have cut back on the quality and quantity of the food they provide us (3 times a day). The Guards and staff won't even eat it. There are many issues that should be addressed.

Ma'am, I am a civilized human being that had a good upbringing. I don't know how to ask, but I believe that God has done this to me for a reason. I am a believer and God knew that I have to see to believe. You may ask why I believe there is a God. I can explain that some other time if you like. I can't understand what I see

and am going through. I know that I am not guilty of any crime. I am here for arson. Quickly I will explain. If the alleged victims testified that they left at 5:35 and they saw me on the front lawn before they ran out the back of the duplex garage door, and the Phila. Fire Dept. arrived at 5:36, how did I run around the back of the home and inside the same way they came out (through the basement and up to the 1st. fl. apt.) set 3 fires of non-communicating points of origin, run out the same way to the front where my car was parked and leave without being seen by anyone, in 1 minute, when it takes at the least 5 min. for PFD to respond and 5 min. for the 2nd. fl. neighbor to smell the smoke from the 1st. fl. apt. to call 911? I had nothing to do with that fire, yet I was nearly murdered for it (found guilty of that too). I know who had every reason in the world to have done it.

Ma'am, I have lost 7 yrs of my life thus far in prison. I will not allow court appointed representation anymore. There is no way that I should have been arrested, prosecuted and (found, not proven) guilty of any crimes. I am now going to represent myself with all of my arguments and the evidence that I was able to obtain upon my own due diligence. I have no one in my corner ma'am. I am not sure if the court is going to accept that they are wrong. They most likely wont. I wrote many people asking for Physical/Emotional support. If the media were there, the court may honor the law. I wish that I could tell you everything that I have been through. I am barely keeping my head above water. Imprisonment is really beginning to take a mental toll on me.

If there is anything that you can do, please know that, I believe I was chosen to go through this because I am a stubborn person, and I am not guilty. To make any difference one day, I have to overturn these convictions or no one will believe me or accept what I say as truth. I need help!

I put a little something together so that "We the People" can think of what is going on in reality. I was born in Sherbrooke, Quebec Canada. I was raised here in the U.S. for most of my life. I've been told that I am more patriotic than most Americans. Maybe because I was lead to believe in everything this country once stood for. This system in itself is crooked, and the prisons are not Correctional facilities, they are more like Concentration Camps anymore. I don't know what prison used to be like because this is my 1st time ever to be imprisoned, but there is nothing about teaching people how to be civilized upon released back into society.

I was told today (11/28/14) by (recently promoted to) Sgt. Munton, that I cannot speak to another inmate (whom stopped me) while I was walking to the chow hall. I've recently heard that there will soon be a divider line (like the streets for cars), and that we will be punished if we cross it, as in shake ones hand, give a hug to, etc. Staff has divided the prison into 2 sides now, keeping anyone from having any contact at all what-so-ever from one side to the other.

This is supposed to be a Correctional Facility, not a Concentration Camp. The majority of the inmates here, will be released back into society one day. It is not uncivilized to talk to someone, to be kind, or to show them love in such a lonely and desolate place such as this where hope is so little. The #1 command in the Holy Bible is LOVE. When I addressed this situation with another (newly promoted) Sgt., I was told not to come to prison (like it was my choice or in my control [sarcastically speaking]). Staff seems to say this often when they want to justify their communism! They forget that this was Gods land 1st. What gives these people the right to run a Concentration Prison Camp? Everything that I've learned about truth, honor, and integrity have been twisted. These days, it's about who the better liar is that seems to be acceptable. Are they preparing "The People" of this country for Statism?

The cartoon article from USA Today shows this country killing and destroying one another. This is not far fetched! Police are killing children instead of using their training and other options 1st., such as Rubber bullets or a Taser (stun) Gun. It's been said by a student that Pepper Spray has been much more effective in stopping a Bear then bullets. In my cases, police never investigated, or even questioned me. I was never afforded the opportunity to provide an alibi, alibi witnesses, evidence that would help them in an investigation, to purge myself.

As citizens of this country, we are supposed to stand United, not destroy and kill one another. Jesus stated, "The thief comes only to steal, kill and destroy" (John 10:10). The thief he speaks of is Satan, the "Prince of Darkness", A.K.A. "the Father of Lies". If "We the People" read the Holy Bible, "We the People" would clearly see that these are the "Signs of the Final Days" that the Bible speaks of (Katrina, and the Tsunami) Luke 21:5-38, (The Twin Towers) Revelations 18, and so forth.

Abraham Lincoln said, "Give a man power and watch his character change." Lincoln prayed for this nation to remain "Under God", yet the Bible no longer exists in the Courtrooms, and "The Pledge of Allegiance" has been changed, if said in schools. Some actually innocent, some guilty of a lesser crime. Most in need of a second chance before being punished to the maximum penalty. And those who are imprisoned with a lot of time on their hands, who will be released back into society one day, should be carefully treated by prison staff because of the fact that Corrections is about teaching inmates how to be Law Abiding citizens upon release, not institutionalize and misinform them of what is right and wrong so they end up having mental issues that will cause them to be a problem to others and communities upon release.

This nation still needs prayer, but it also needs Us "The People" to Stand United with honor, integrity, and truth to hopefully make a difference one day soon. If we don't, what we do today, will certainly keep effecting our generations to come.

An 80's Hair-Band called White Lion uses a verse in their song; "When the Children Cry", in which is and will be more true than ever if nobody cares to help correct the malfeasance of this system. "All that we destroy, you must build again." This system is vicious and very unforgiving. Every parent wants the best for their children. So why do we make it their responsibility to work harder at what we destroy? It makes no sense! It has been said, "One who does nothing in a time of crisis, is as guilty as one who causes a crisis."

"The people" need to decide on what they want. People fought, shed blood, suffered, and died for us years ago in the Revolutionary War to have life and liberty. Many of the Constitutional Rights we once had, have been compromised, justified and lost their value in the judicial system. What are we teaching our children if we are not being an example? Don't get me wrong. I have no sympathy for serial killers and terrorists. It is every persons responsibility to have reached out for help first and foremost. The question lies whether or not anyone tried to help them. There is still no justification to hurt anyone else. Serial Killers and terrorists deserve every bit of punishment that they get.

Me in particular, am not guilty of the charges brought against myself. In fact, I was the victim in a case where a family chose to take justice into their own hands. I was found guilty of that crime too. What some people don't seem to understand is, how much a father loves his children. I love my children as much as I can! And I want what is best for them. They are why I keep trying.

As I said, I am not guilty of any crime. I was found guilty on hearsay (from a bitter ex who was only able to slandered my character), conjecture and speculation. There was never any evidence to prove my guilt. I've never been convicted of anything before in my life. I was told that I am a fool for not taking a jury. I didn't know better! Now, I've reached out to hundreds of people who could help me if they wanted, but have chosen to turn a blind eye instead. It is sad indeed because I can now prove my innocence. I can only surmise how much more evidence would have been made available to me, had I not been incarcerated. What I and my children have experienced from the PA. system is a "Lifetime" movie. I can only pray that one day, I will be heard. I am tired and I need someone that I can rely on.
