Secretary Dortch,

The FCC's proposal referenced above is the superior fit to enhance E911 response in Yazoo City. Emergency dispatchers are not able to locate the GPS of a wireless device during a 911 call. The latest indoor location accuracy technology will aid response to potentially save thousands of lives nationwide. Most calls to 911 are placed indoors from cell phones. The time lapse between the call and dispatch is critical.

Wireless companies have drafted an alternative proposal designed to keep them in business without regard to the best interests of public safety. I support the FCC's proposal for wireless E911 indoor location accuracy action and ask that you take that support into consideration.
