

Enclosed is a letter from XO Communications, LLC ("XO") to counter the assertions made in this proceeding that the current Local Number Portability Administrator ("LNPA") selection process (the "LNPA Selection Process"): (1) excluded participation by certain providers or industry sectors, (2) failed to appropriately incorporate the ongoing transition to IP-based networks, or (3) neglected to include sufficient evaluation of the financial impacts of a transition to a new LNPA vendor.
