

In the Matter of RM No. 11737

Please record my opposition to the Petitioners' request, on the grounds that the petitioners' proposed use of the Part 15 spectrum constitutes a misuse of Part 15, which is intended to allow unlicensed use of the spectrum by "communications devices" and not by devices intended to prevent communications.

By utilizing such devices to prevent communications, the Petitioners abuse the intent of Part 15, which is to provide spectrum for the unlicensed use by the public for communications, and attempt to take proprietary ownership of public spectrum without compensation, for the purpose of creating a monopoly and utilizing that monopoly to seek rents.

The FCC should make clear that the Petitioners' right to utilize Part 15 devices for communication does not confer any right to utilize the devices to prevent the communications of others, and does not confer any right to monopoly rents from the control of the use of the corresponding spectrum.
