**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO DESIGNATE CONFIDENTIAL
AND HIGHLY CONFIDENTIAL PORTIONS OF THE HEARING TRANSCRIPT**

Maritime Communications/Land Mobile, LLC (“Maritime”), by its attorney, hereby seeks an extension of time in which to designate portions of the hearing transcript as confidential and/or highly confidential.

The trial phase of the hearing on Issue G was held on December 9, 10, and 11, 2104. On December 31, 2014, undersigned counsel learned for the first time (via an email message from

counsel for the Enforcement Bureau) that the transcript had possibly become available as of December 29, 2014. On that same date undersigned counsel sent an email communication and left a voice mail message with the court reporter seeking to order a copy of the transcript. Due to the intervening holidays, the court reporter had not responded as of today, Monday, January 5, 2015. Undersigned counsel spoke with someone at the court reporter's offices earlier this morning and learned that the person normally dealing with FCC transcripts has been out for the holidays. While nothing has yet been officially confirmed by the court reporter, undersigned counsel anticipates being provided with the necessary information to order and obtain a transcript sometime later today, and hopes to have the transcript no later than tomorrow.

The procedures regarding treatment of the hearing transcript, in particular with regard to the designation of appropriate portions thereof for confidential treatment, are governed by the *Protective Order* (FCC 11M-21; July 20, 2011) and *Order* (FCC 12M-44; Dec. 19, 2014).

Paragraph 10(b) of the Protective Order provides in relevant part:

The transcripts of oral hearing testimony and oral argument will be considered Confidential Information or Highly Confidential Information until seven (7) business days after the transcript for the last day of the hearing involving the Parties to this Protective Order is made available to the Parties by the hearing reporter. During this period, any of the Reviewing Parties may designate portions of the transcripts as Confidential Information or Highly Confidential Information by identifying the page numbers and specific language so designated in a confidential submission filed with the Office of the Secretary and served on counsel to each of the Parties.

If the seven business days referred to is deemed to have commenced on December 29, 2014, the deadline for designating portions of the transcript would be in only three days from now, i.e., on Thursday, January 8, 2015. As stated above, however, was never officially advised of the availability of the transcript; only learned unofficially of its possible availability on December 31, 2014; and despite diligently acting on such information, still has not been able to obtain a copy of the transcript.

In view of the foregoing, it is respectfully requested by the deadline for designating portions of the transcript as confidential or highly confidential pursuant to Paragraph 10(b) of the Protective Order be extended for one week, to and including Thursday, January 15, 2015.
